- All articles should be typed on portrait orientation (except where necessary), in A4 size paper, not more than 20 pages long, using 12 points font, Time New Roman, with double line spacing.
- The title page should contain the title and authors' affiliation.
- The second page should contain an abstract of not more than 250 words which captures the main objective, methodology, findings/contribution to knowledge and recommendation(s) of the articles.
- · Citation and References should be APA 6th edition.
