- ✓ *A career is an occupation or profession, especially one requiring special training, followed as one's lifework.*

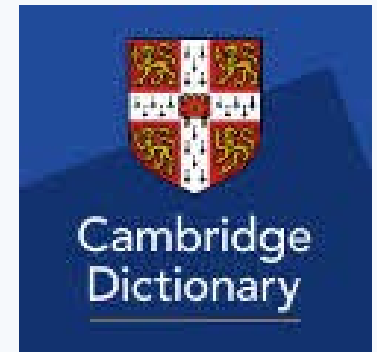


# The Concept Of Career (2/2)

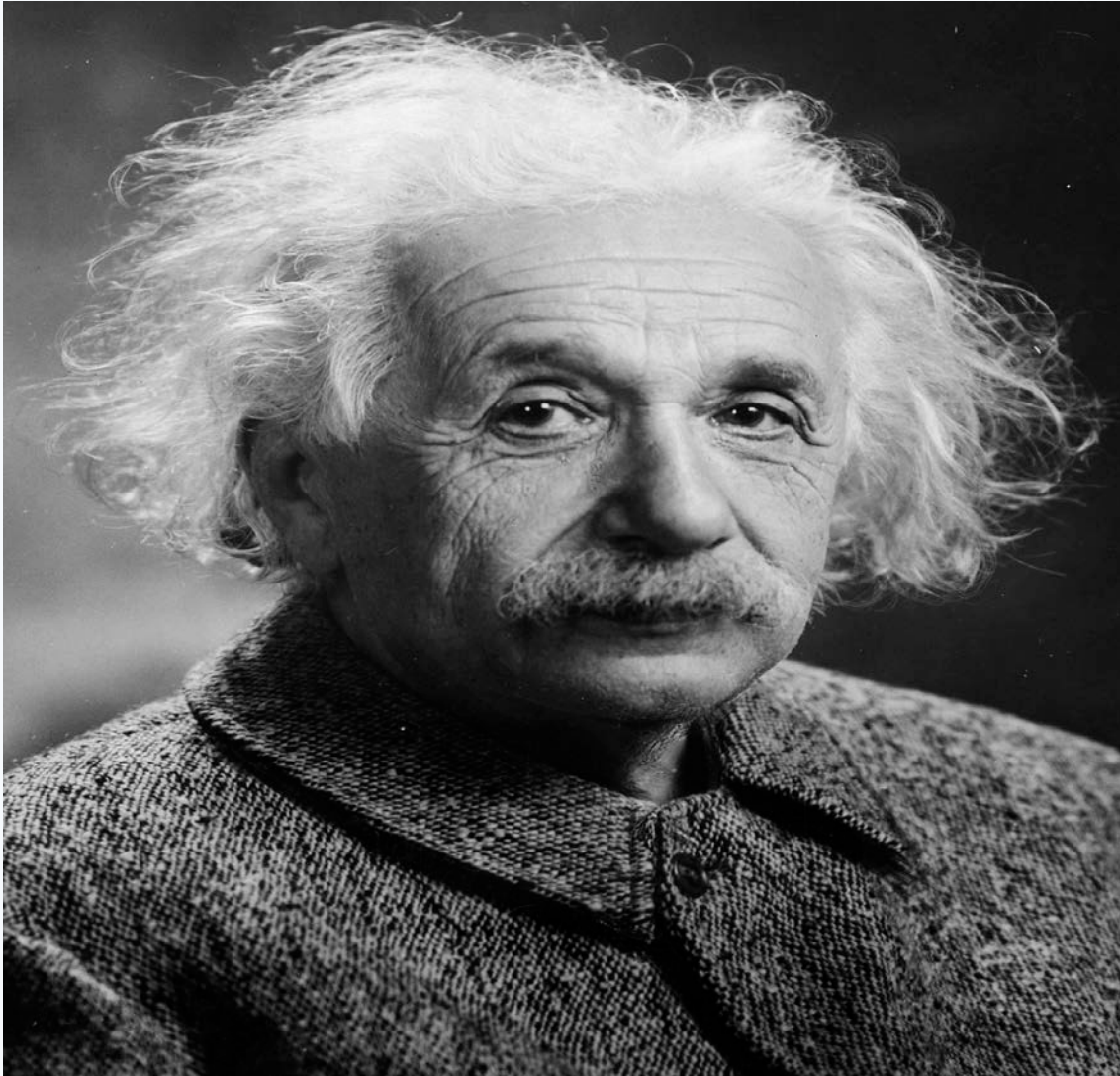

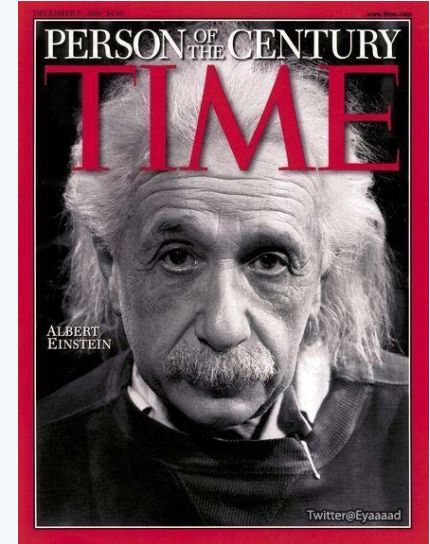

# FOCUS

---

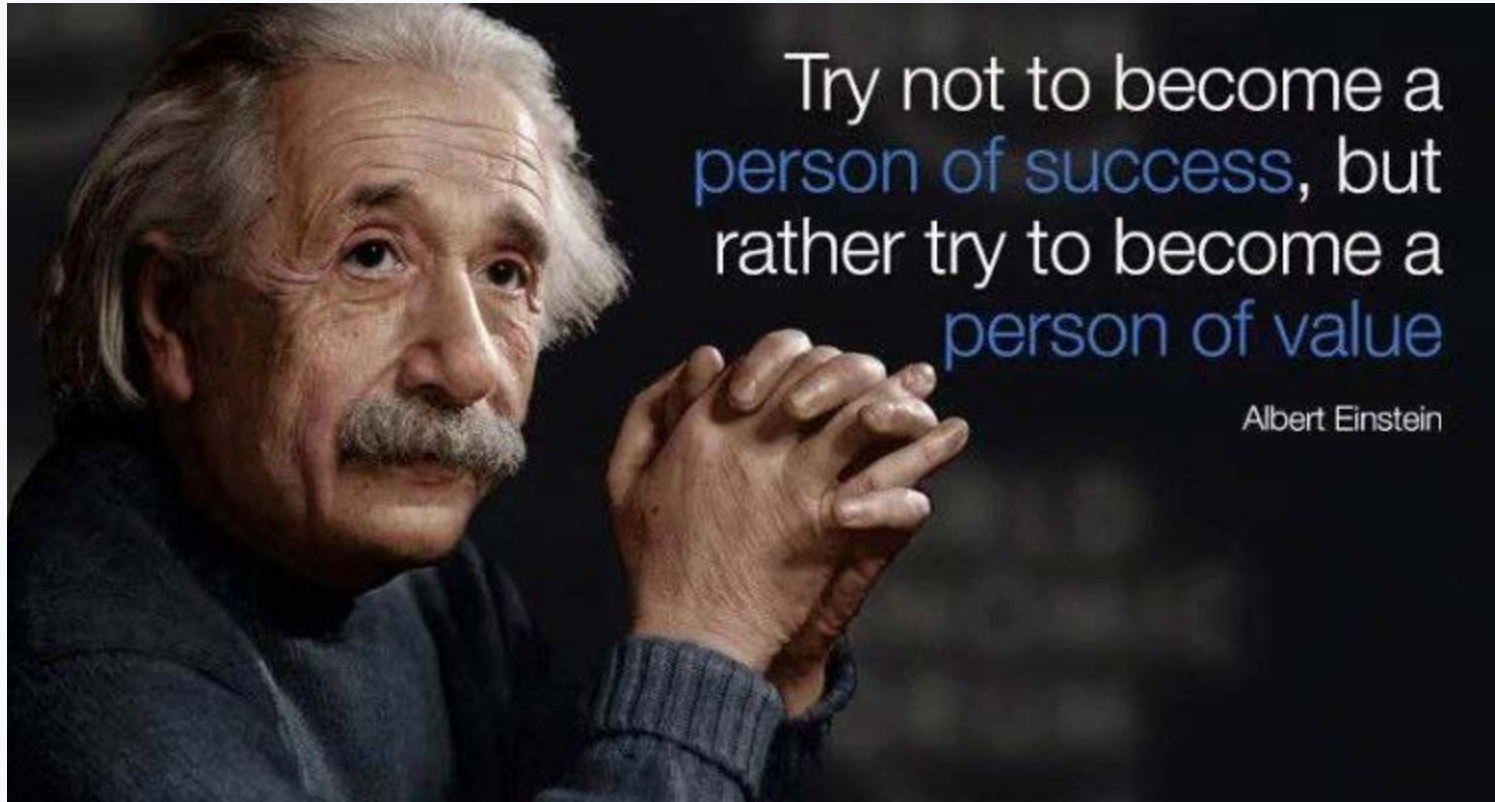

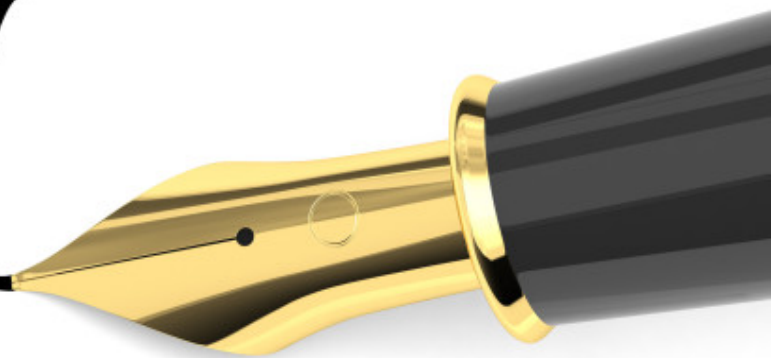
