



PRIVATE AUDIT FIRM ASSESSMENT

The World Bank will be conducting an assessment of private audit firms interested in auditing World Bank funded projects in order to strengthen fiduciary arrangements that will ensure quality audit reports are received by both the World Bank and the Government of Nigeria. The Bank will work closely with the Office of the Auditor General for the Federation, Financial Reporting Council of Nigeria, Institute of Chartered Accountants of Nigeria and the Association of National Accountants of Nigeria while conducting the assessment. The methodology to be used during the assessment, will be based on the International Standards on Quality Control (ISQC 1) issued by the International Auditing and Assurance Standards Board (IAASB) of the International Federation of Accountants.

We therefore invite private external audit firms interested in conducting the audit of World Bank funded projects to fill a questionnaire that can be accessed from the following website **www.worldbank.org**. We shall also work closely with the Institute of Chartered Accountants of Nigeria and the Association of National Accountants of Nigeria to circulate the questionnaire to their members.
