Introduction

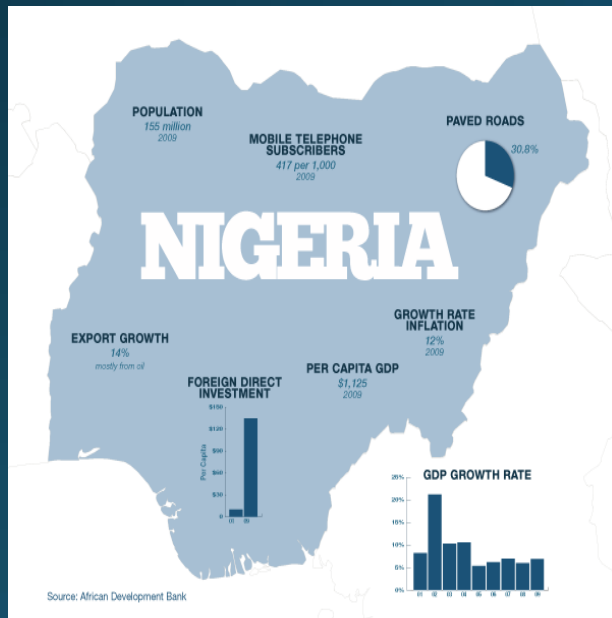
