CONDITIONS FOR THE RENEWAL OF EXPIRED PRACTICE LICENCE

Members wishing to renew their expired licence should apply to the Institute, stating compliance with the following terms and conditions of the licence renewal process:

1. The member must be a financial member of the Institute.
2. He/she must have paid the annual licence renewal fee of N15,000
3. He/she must be a financial member of an ICAN District Society and also confirmed by that (or any other) District to be in full-time practice in an audit firm located in the District.
4. He/she must have obtained a minimum of 90 credit hours in last 3 consecutive years through the attendance of MCPE programs and other Institute's activities.
5. The members' audit firm must be registered (link for registration of firm) with the Institute. After registration, the members should contact the Institute through the under listed phone number or email to confirm that the firm has indeed been registered in the system. There will be no need to submit any document as evidence of registration.
6. The member must undertake in writing to abide by all practice monitoring/review and other regulations that may be issued by the Institute from time to time.

NOTE:

- A. The application letter to the Institute must be in the firm's letter head paper.
- B. A copy of the expired practice licence and evidence of payment of the renewal fee and other relevant information
